Derant's Privacy Policy was posted on 16/09/2021 and was last updated on 01/09/2021. This privacy policy is meant to help users to understand what personal data Derant collect, why we collect it and their rights as data subjects.

What data do Derant collect

Derant may collect and process the following data about you:

- **Contact and identity data** such as your name, e-mail, address and phone number
- **Technical Data** Including your internet protocol (IP) address, login data, operating system and web browser type, browser plug-in types and version, traffic data, location data and other communication data, and the resources that you access.
- **Usage data** including how you use our website, product and services
- **Profile data** Including username, password and feedback data.
- **Marketing and Communications Data** including your preferences in receiving marketing from us and your communication preferences.

How do we collect your data

Derant may collect your personal data when you:

- Contact us and/or provide feedback
- Enter and use our website: As you interact with our website, we will automatically collect Technical Data about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns. We collect this personal data by using cookies and other similar technologies. We may also receive Technical Data about you if you visit other websites employing our cookies
- Provide contact details (e.g. giving business cards) at a marketing event.
- Request and receive marketing communications
- Submit a job application: If you are making a job application or inquiry, you may provide us with a copy of your CV or other relevant information. We may use this information for the purpose of considering your application or inquiry. Except when you explicitly request otherwise, we may keep this information on file for future reference.
- Purchase our products and services: If you purchase or use our products or services, we may use your personal data for purposes which include but are not limited to:
 - o verifying your credentials,
 - o carrying out end user compliance checks for export control purposes,
 - o processing orders and generating billing information.
- Through our business relationships and contacts.

How will Derant use your data

Derant may use the personal data held about you in the following circumstances:

- Customer support
- Administrative purposes, including login to self-service portals, invoicing, and service messages
- Targeted communications, e.g., through newsletters, invitations to technical seminars, digital advertising on social media
- Market surveys
- Marketing, in general
- Personal contact

Security

Your rights
